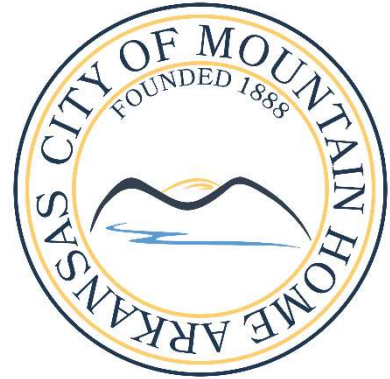

**MINUTES**  
**REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING – Thursday, March 7th, 2024**

1. The Mountain Home City Council met in regular session on March 7th, 2024, in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building. Mayor Hillrey Adams called the meeting to order at 5 p.m.
2. **CITY OFFICIALS IN ATTENDANCE** Mayor Hillrey Adams, City Clerk Scott Liles, City Attorney Roger Morgan, Public Works Director Steve Hill, Police Chief Eddie Griffin and Fire Chief Chris Quick.
3. **MEDIA IN ATTENDANCE** Chris Fulton of the Mountain Home Observer and Caroline Spears of the Baxter Bulletin. The meeting was also streamed on Facebook by XL-7 TV.
4. **ROLL CALL** Following the Pledge of Allegiance and an invocation, the following Council members were present for the roll call: Bob Van Haaren, Susan Stockton, Wayne Almond, Paige Evans, Carry Manuel, Jim Bodenhamer and Nick Reed. Jennifer Baker was absent from the roll call but arrived at 5:10 p.m. before any action could be taken under Old Business.
5. **APPROVAL OF THE FEBRUARY 15<sup>th</sup> MINUTES** Council member Susan Stockton made a motion to approve the minutes from the Council's February 15th meeting. The motion was seconded by Council member Carry Manuel. *The vote was recorded as follows: Yes – Bob Van Haaren, Susan Stockton, Wayne Almond, Paige Evans, Carry Manuel, Jim Bodenhamer and Nick Reed. Absent – Jennifer Baker. The motion carried, and the February 15th minutes were adopted.*
6. **NEW BUSINESS**

**SALE OF THE MHPD BUILDING AND THE PURCHASE OF THE BUILDING AT 650 SOUTH STREET** City attorney Roger Morgan opened discussion on this issue by noting that the three items listed in numerical order on the agenda – sale of the Mountain Home Police Department building at 424 West 7<sup>th</sup> Street, a resolution to waive competitive bidding on the sale of the PD building, and the purchase of a building at 650 South Street were all facets of the same issue, and as such the individual topics might be addressed out of the order presented on the agenda.

If approved by the Council, the City would sell the current MHPD building at 424 West 7<sup>th</sup> Street to the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission for \$1,118,000 and in turn purchase the former bank building located at 650 South Street from F5 Investments for \$720,000 and then renovate it into the next MHPD building. Moving the MHPD into the former bank building would give the department an additional 3,000 square feet of space, place the PD adjacent to the Baxter County court complex and give the PD a more prominent location in downtown Mountain Home that is easier for visitors to find.

Council discussed the issue with the public for 45 minutes and heard from several attendees on the issue – Hap Myers, Michele Linehan, Shelia Atchley, Debbie Anderson and Mary O’Shields. Some of the issues raised were why the City had not commissioned its own appraisal of the bank building; why the City was waiving bidding on the sale of the MHPD building; and the potential expense of renovating an older building.

As to the bid waivers, Morgan noted that with each part of the sale/purchase being contingent on the other, he was unsure how you could conduct this transaction any other way. The City could accept bids for the MHPD building, but there’s no guarantee that it would end up in the same position to purchase the property at 650 South Street, he said.

Police Chief Eddie Griffin noted that the bid waivers discussed Thursday night were not waiving any potential bidding on renovation work to be carried out on property at 650 South Street. The City could complete some of the work in-house with City employees and still solicit construction bids for any work that it did not conduct itself.

Council member Paige Evans said she would like the City to commission its own appraisal of the 650 South Street property since previous appraisals by the AGFC and F5 Investments differed by several hundred thousand dollars.

**CLERK’S NOTE** *After researching the issues involved, it was ultimately decided that four Resolutions would be adopted to sell the MHPD building and purchase the property at 650 South Street – a Resolution waiving bidding on the sale of the MHPD building to the AGFC; a Resolution authorizing the City to sell the building to the AGFC; a Resolution waiving bidding on the purchase of the building at 650 South Street; and a Resolution authorizing the City to purchase the 650 South Street building.*

**A RESOLUTION WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING ON THE SALE OF THE MOUNTAIN HOME POLICE DEPARTMENT BUILDING**

If approved by Council, this Resolution would allow the City to sell the current MHPD building, located at 424 West 7<sup>th</sup> Street, without first accepting bids on the property. Council member Jim Bodenhamer made a motion to adopt the Resolution and was seconded by Council member Bob Van Haaren. *The vote was recorded as follows: Yes -- Bob Van Haaren, Susan Stockton, Jennifer Baker, Wayne Almond, Carry Manuel, Jim Bodenhamer and Nick Reed. No – Paige Evans. The Resolution was declared adopted and numbered Resolution No. 2024-7.*

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF THE MOUNTAIN HOME POLICE DEPARTMENT BUILDING TO THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH COMMISSION FOR A SUM**

**OF \$1,118,000.00** If approved, this Resolution would allow the City to sell the building at 424 West 7<sup>th</sup> Street, commonly known as the MHPD building, to the Arkansas Game and Fish for \$1,118,000. Council member Jim Bodenhamer made a motion to adopt the Resolution and was seconded by Council member Bob Van Haaren. *The vote was recorded as follows: Yes -- Bob Van Haaren, Susan Stockton, Jennifer Baker, Wayne Almond, Carry Manuel, Jim Bodenhamer and Nick Reed. No – Paige Evans. The Resolution was declared adopted and numbered Resolution No. 2024-8.*

**A RESOLUTION WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING ON THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY AND REAL ESTATE LOCATED AT 650 SOUTH STREET IN MOUNTAIN HOME, ARKANSAS**

If approved by Council, this Resolution would waive the bidding on the purchase of the property located at 650 South Street. The City's bidding structure requires bids to be sought out when purchasing items or equipment more than \$20,000 unless such bids are not feasible or practical. Council member Jim Bodenhamer made a motion to adopt the Resolution and was seconded by Council member Bob Van Haaren. *The vote was recorded as follows: Yes -- Bob Van Haaren, Susan Stockton, Jennifer Baker, Wayne Almond, Carry Manuel, Jim Bodenhamer and Nick Reed. No – Paige Evans. The Resolution was declared adopted and numbered Resolution No. 2024-9.*

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN HOME TO PURCHASE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 650 SOUTH STREET FROM F5 INVESTMENTS LLC FOR THE SUM OF \$720,000.00**

If approved by Council, this Resolution would allow the City to purchase the building at 650 South Street from F5 Investments for \$720,000. Council member Bob Van Haaren made the motion to adopt the Resolution and was seconded by Council member Susan Stockton. *The vote was recorded as follows: Yes -- Bob Van Haaren, Susan Stockton, Jennifer Baker, Wayne Almond, Carry Manuel, Jim Bodenhamer and Nick Reed. No – Paige Evans. The Resolution was declared adopted and numbered Resolution No. 2024-10.*

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION OF REAL PROPERTY FOR EXTENSION OF SEWER LINE**

City attorney Roger Morgan reported that the landowner involved in this potential Resolution, Rhonda "Tink" Albright had signed the easement the City was needing, and that this Resolution was no longer necessary.

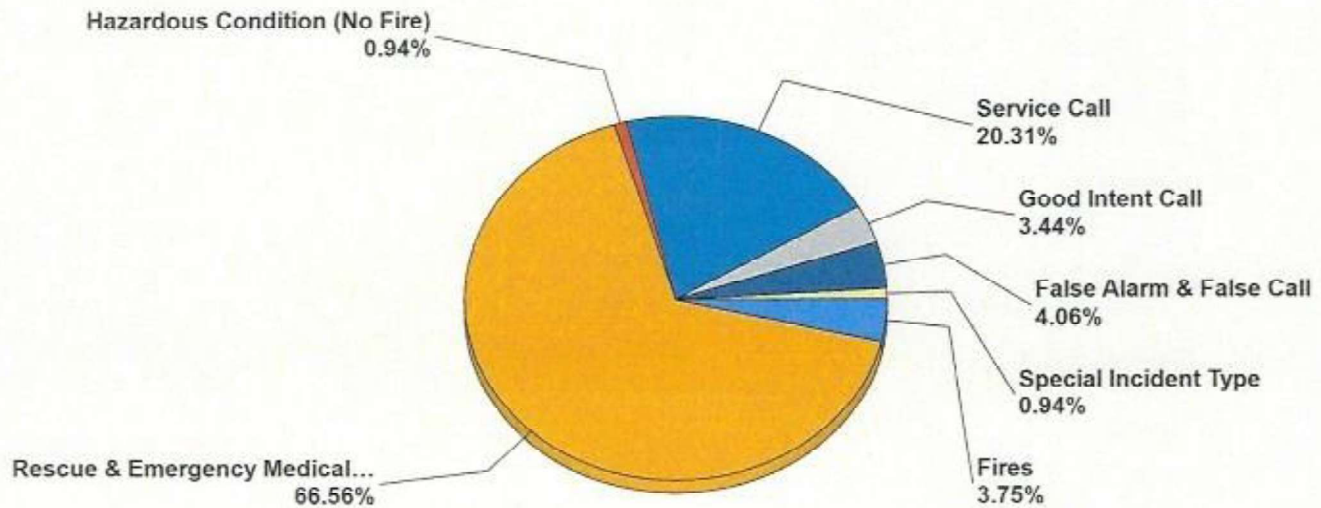
