DESCRIPTION

DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this position is to set forms and provide related functions to the placing and finishing of concrete street construction and to perform related street maintenance tasks.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) Assist in the construction of forms, setting grades, setting forms and other related tasks in new street construction.
- 2) Constructs storm sewers, drainpipes, manhole and catch basins.
- 3) Possession of valid CDL License, or the ability to obtain within six months of employment
- 4) Places and finishes concrete.
- 5) Operates equipment, machinery, and tools such as jackhammers, rotary drills, cutting torches, concrete mixers, chain and concrete saws, etc.
- 6) Drives dump truck and operates backhoe as needed.
- 7) Spread sand and gravel and clears streets of snow and ice as needed.
- 8) The employee is responsible for checking all fluid levels, hydraulic systems, and visual inspection of all belts, hoses, tires, and pivot points of equipment and/or vehicles that the employee may be assigned.
- 9) Performs other related duties as assigned.

SPECIFIC KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES OR EDUCATION:

- 1) Knowledge of departmental and safety rules and regulations.
- 2) Skill in setting forms and support work to concrete finishing.
- 3) Skill in utilizing tools, equipment and machinery in concrete finishing.
- 4) Skill in driving.
- 5) Skill in following oral instructions.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

The physical demands described herein are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodation may be provided to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions and expectations. While performing the functions of this job, the employee must be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Work is typically performed outdoors exposing the employee to machinery with moving parts, noise, dust, dirt, and grease, irritating chemicals, hot/increment weather, and sometimes to the extreme heat of asphalt. This work may require the use of protective devices such as masks, gloves, goggles, etc., and may be required at any time of day or night during emergencies. Employees may also be exposed to irritating vegetation such as poison ivy and poison oak. Physical demands typically include standing, stooping, bending, crouching, walking, frequently lifting objects weighing as much as one hundred pounds, climbing ladders, using tools requiring manual and physical dexterity, and physically exerting oneself over long periods of time.


MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:
